I, the undersigned Professor Massimo Cotroneo, in my capacity as Director and legal representative of the Luca Marenzio Conservatory of Music in Brescia, while deeply appreciating the MUVIE - Music for Visually Impaired - project and fully sharing its principles and objectives, regretfully have to communicate the withdrawal of the institution I represent from its role as a beneficiary partner in the project.

This decision is due to the emergence of significant new institutional commitments that arose after our initial participation agreement and which now prevent us from participating in the project. As of February 2024, the Conservatory of Brescia has undertaken several demanding activities in addition to its regular commitments, which I will outline below:

- Participation in the EUartNET internationalization project, within the framework of Ministerial Decree no. 124 of 19 July 2023, issued by the Ministry of Universities and Research.
- Activation of university and academic training courses for the initial training and qualification of teachers, in accordance with the Prime Ministerial Decree of 4 August 2023.
- Establishment of research doctorates in accordance with Ministerial Decrees 629 and 630 of 24 April 2024.
- Orientation activities for high schools, in accordance with Ministerial Decree No. 934 of 3 August 2022.

Finally, I confirm that the Institution has not incurred any expenditure in relation to the project from the date of approval to date.
